## Lions Club/Camp Creek Greenway

## **Project Narrative**

We plan to construct a 12' wide concrete and asphalt trail to connect Camp Creek Greenway to the amenities area of Lions Club Park. The trail will begin in the Rockbridge Road right-of-way on the North side of Camp Creek, follow along Camp Creek as it runs under the bridge at Rockbridge Road, follow along the South side of Rockbridge Road for approximately 400 feet, then turn South, past the baseball fields, terminating at the parking lot.

It is necessary for the trail to be close to Camp Creek where it crosses under Rockbridge Road. Therefore, it will be located within the 25' buffer and will require a buffer variance from the EPD. We will engage the services of design consultants appropriate to the project, and get all required permits before beginning construction. Gwinnett County will obtain bids for the work and the contractor will be required to abide by the permitted plans. We do not know of any endangered species or historic resources that would be affected by this work.

This greenway route was shown in the Gwinnett County 2002 Open Space and Greenway Master Plan. Lilburn constructed a portion of Camp Creek Greenway in 2007, but the connection at Rockbridge Road still needs to be completed. Lilburn has agreed to continue to maintain the greenway and monitor the crossing at Camp Creek, so that we can clear silt and debris from the trail after rain events. Since 2005, the County has had an agreement with the City of Lilburn to lease Lions Club Park for 50 years and make capital improvements to the park. The park is scheduled for renovation in 2010, and we expect to include this trail connection as part of that project.
