Department of Community Development Recommendation:

APPROVAL of a Resolution for Transmittal of the Annual Capital Improvements Element (CIE) Update.

Background:

The Annual Financial Report has been adjusted to reflect the 2019-2020 beginning balances, impact fees collected and accrued interest for each public facility type. The Work Program was updated to show change in estimated costs of specific Public Safety and Road Improvements projects and to include subprojects of intersection improvements, as listed in the Community Work Program chapter of the CIE adopted October 18, 2016.

All local governments that utilize an impact fee system under the Georgia Development Impact Fee Act (GDIFA) must include a Capital Improvements Element (CIE) in their comprehensive plans and update the Capital Improvements Element (CIE) portion of their plan annually. The City of Sandy Springs is required to approve an annual update to a Capital Improvements Element and Short Term Work Program by October 31, 2019.

Discussion:

The State requires that only a draft be submitted and that the local governments not take any official action to adopt or put into effect a CIE prepared in accordance with the Development Impact Fee Compliance Requirements until at least 60 days after the CIE is first submitted to the regional development center for review (the Atlanta Regional Commission). The draft of the annual update of the Capital Improvements Element and Work Program has been prepared by Staff in accordance with the Development Impact Fees Compliance Requirements and the Minimum Planning Standard and Procedures for Local Comprehensive Planning established by the state of Georgia.

The following estimated costs for the Public Safety and Road Improvements projects listed below have changed since last year's CIE (but do not exceed our original budget):

Public Safety

- 1. Purchase fire engine
- 2. Purchase ladder fire truck
- 3. Construct Public Safety Complex
- 4. Purchase Rescue/Airlight/Rehab Truck
