Notice of Intent to Request a Permit Modification

Damar Incorporated Facility

Damar Incorporated intends to petition the Georgia Environmental Protection Division (EPD) for termination of its permit under the Georgia Hazardous Waste Management Act. This petition will request that the site be declassified as a hazardous waste facility so that it may be sold to a prospective purchaser for development under the Georgia Hazardous Site Reuse and Redevelopment Act.

The permit termination and sale of the property will result in: (a) a more aggressive clean-up of the subject property that is more protective of public health and the environment than the course under the present permit, and (b) the restoration of the property to beneficial use.

A draft application will be available by January 4, 2006, for review at the Cobb County Public Library, 266 Roswell Street, Marietta, Georgia, 30060 during normal hours of operation. The document is titled "Draft Corrective Action Plan for RCRA Permit Termination and Corrective Action Plan for Prospective Purchaser Under the Georgia Hazardous Site Reuse and Redevelopment Act".

The document will be available for review for approximately sixty (60) days from your receipt of this notice. Damar Incorporated will receive comments during that period and prior to its submittal of the formal application to EPD.
