Program Narrative

Project: *Runway 31 Overrun and Associated Taxiways*

Airport: *Peachtree City – Falcon Field*

Objective

The construction of Runway 31 overrun and associated taxiways will provide operational improvements and will also increase the safety of the airport by simultaneously displacing the existing threshold.

Benefits Anticipated

Based on the application of threshold siting standards, the Runway 31 threshold will be displaced 130' from the existing location. The runway end will be extended 740' to the southeast, providing an overrun length while still meeting clearance requirements over the existing CSX Railroad. The 600' runway safety area length prior to landing will be provided within this increased pavement length. Declared distances may be implemented to provide the necessary safety area dimensions, thereby improving the safety at Peachtree City – Falcon Field.

Approach

A 740' extension will be built to the southeast of the existing Runway 31 threshold. A taxiway system will service the terminal / ramp area and Hangar Area "B" to the north, while a southern taxiway connection will service Hangar Area "C". The entire development is located within a previously disturbed area. This project includes the design phase only. A separate application for construction will follow at a later date.

Geographic Location

The project area is located southeast of the Runway 31 threshold and includes a 740' paved overrun, and two parallel taxiways with connectors.
