Project Details

Federal funds included in this FY07 grant will be used to purchase an approximately 1.657 parcel of land, located at 680 South Marietta Parkway, which is adjacent to the existing CCT Multi-Use Transit Facility. The land will be used to expand the current Maintenance and Administrative facilities. The project includes demolition of existing buildings, and repaving the existing parking lot. FTA notified Cobb County on 12/19/06 that the property appraisal for this parcel of land had been approved.

The FY07 grant funds will also be used to assist with the construction costs related to the expansion of the Acworth and Mableton Park and Ride lots. The County is in process of purchasing an additional 2.5 acres to expand the Acworth Park & Ride lot and these funds will be used in conjunction with existing grants for construction costs related to this expansion.

The FY07 grant funds will also be used for Phase 2 of the Mableton Park & Ride lot expansion which will include building a bus shelter, a bus driveway with heavier pavement section, lighting, grading, drainage, pavement, striping, and fencing.

The FY07 grant funds will also be used for construction management services for renovation of the CCT facility and the Acworth and Mableton Park & Ride lot projects.
