Cherokee County Board of Commissioners is in the process of acquiring a permium bus transportation & intermodal facility to store, maintain, and operate its Xpress Coach and 5311 rural transportation programs. The facility \$1.55 million facility (\$53 a sq ft) is strategically, conveniently & ideally located to meet all of the transit needs of the county. This facility could not be 'built' for such a low price. The 29,600 sq ft facility is perfect for the county's growing transportation needs as needed coac service for the 67% of CC residents who work in the ATL Metro area. The facility will be used as headquarters to operate a 1-stop shop of transportation and provide the necessary storage and security for all transportation vehicles.
