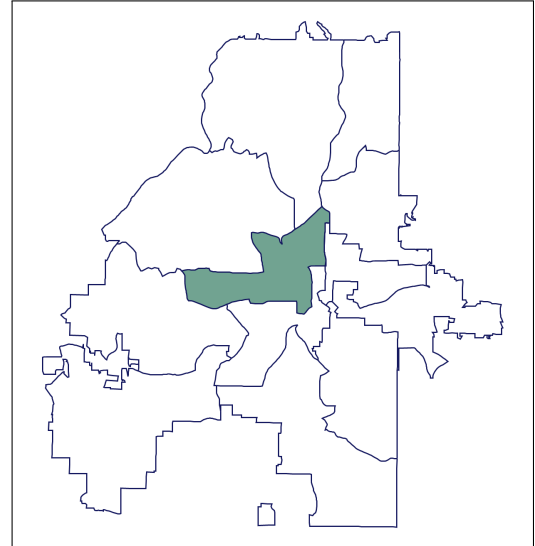




# Atlanta City Council District 3
