Detailed Description and Justification

The BeltLine SW Trail, Allene Avenue to Lena Street is 3.5 miles long and is within the Southwest and Northwest Zones of the BeltLine project. The project would comprise extensions to the north and south of the existing and under construction portions of the West End BeltLine trail. It would run within the abandoned L&N railroad corridor. The project would include a concrete trail up to 16' wide and associated access stairs and ramps and amenities including seating areas and landscaping. The project would connect neighborhoods, retail areas, existing and new greenspaces, an existing MARTA station and several proposed BeltLine stations. It would also connect to the Southwest BeltLine Connector trail, an initial segment of which is under construction.
