## Detailed Description and Justification

Nationwide, FTA Section 5307 funds are available for transit improvements for urbanized areas. In the case of the Atlanta urbanized area, the designated recipient is the Metropolitan Atlanta Rapid Transit Authority (MARTA). Funds are apportioned to urbanized areas utilizing a formula based on population, population density and other factors associated with transit service and ridership. Funds can be used for transit planning, engineering and design of transit facilities, capital purchases of transit equipment, facilities and infrastructure, maintenance of transit equipment, facilities and infrastructure, and some paratransit operating costs. For a breakdown of how these funds are used in the region, refer to the Transit Program Appendix of the TIP.
