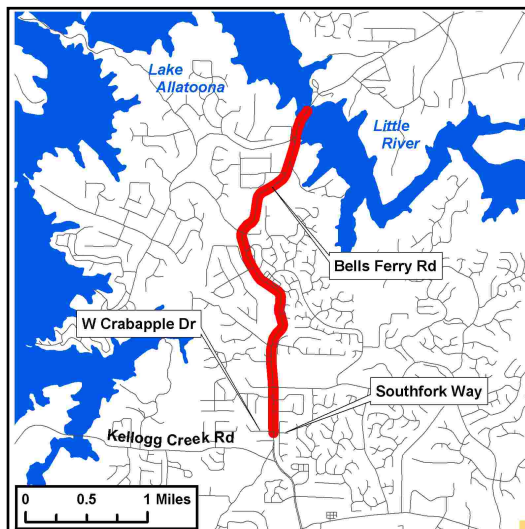

## Detailed Description and Justification

This project widens and realigns Bells Ferry Road from Southfork Way to Victoria Road. Bells Ferry Road is a 4 lane facility from I-575 in Cobb County, north into Cherokee County, where it transitions down to a 2 lane facility at Southfork Way. A majority of the traffic on Bells Ferry Road originates in Cherokee County at the proposed Victoria Road terminus of this project. Bells Ferry Road carries traffic from western Cherokee County to Cobb County. Bells Ferry Road serves as a parallel north/south route to I-575 through Cherokee County, during AM and PM peak hours, for residents residing in western Cherokee County travelling to Cobb County. The project concept was approved by GDOT in 1998.
