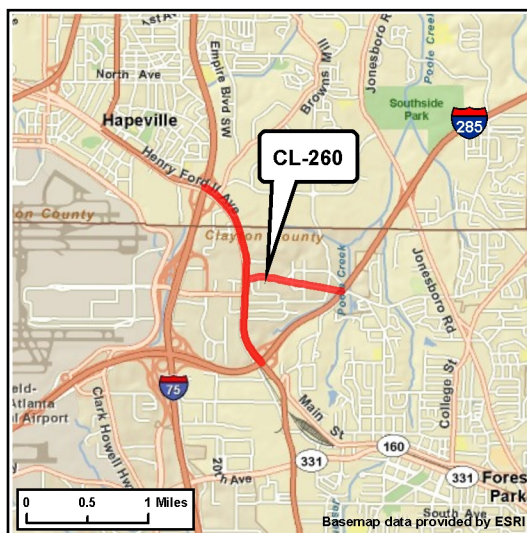

Detailed Description and Justification

Construction of a grade separation placing C.W. Grant Parkway (f.k.a. Aviation Boulevard) under the Norfolk Southern railroad and Old Dixie Highway. The roadway will maintain four lanes, a 20 foot median, five-foot sidewalks, and curb and gutter. The widening of US 19/41 to four lanes will be from I-75 to I-285. The widening of Conley Road to four lanes will be from US 19/41 to I-285. A connection between the grade-separated C.W. Grant Parkway and Old Dixie Highway is also included.
