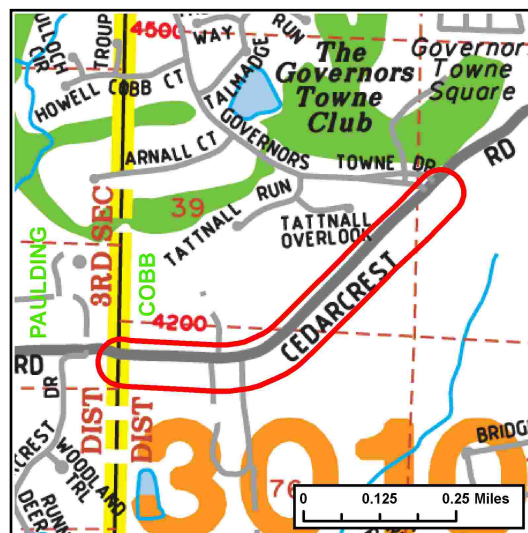

## Detailed Description and Justification

This project includes widening Cedarcrest Road from the Paulding County line to Governor's Towne Drive, from 2 to 4 lanes. This project is an extension of a planned project widen Cedarcrest Road in Paulding County. The existing Volume/Capacity ratio on Cedarcrest Road is 1.01 and without improvements this roadway will experience severe congestion. New sidewalks, crosswalks, landscaping, and pedestrian scale lighting will be included as part of this project. The goal of this project is to alleviate current congestion levels and to improve the pedestrian network.
