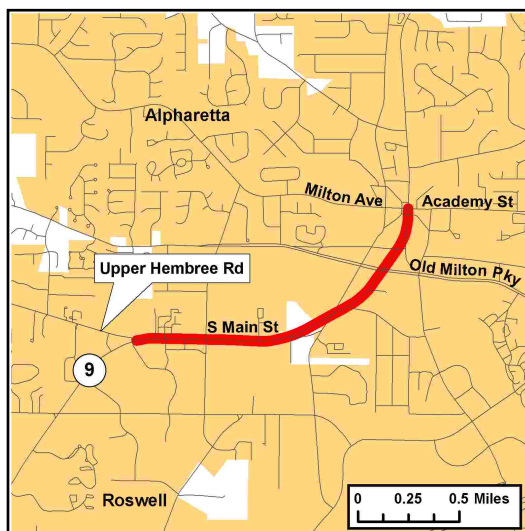

Detailed Description and Justification

This project entails roadway operational modifications along SR 9/South Main Street from Upper Hembree Road to Academy Street. The project will be 1.7 miles in length consisting of a reconstruction of SR 9, reconfiguration of sideroads, pedestrian improvements, and signal upgrades.
