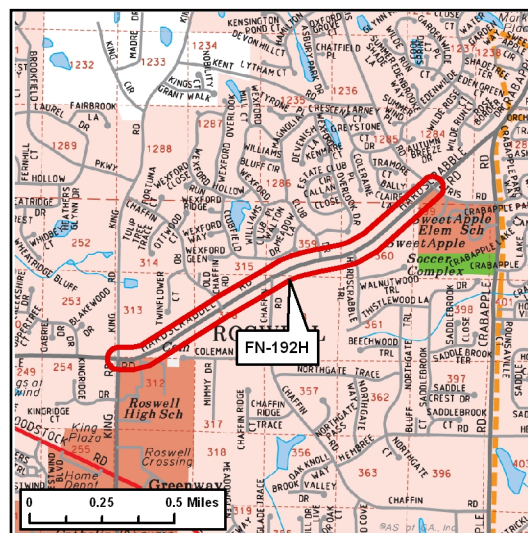

Detailed Description and Justification

This project will construct a segment of the Roswell Loop, Green Route along Hardscrabble Road from King Road to Etris Road connecting Roswell High School to Sweet Apple Elementary School and Sweet Apple Park. The trail will be 10 feet wide and will be located along the south side of Hardscrabble Road. The project also includes turn lane additions to the intersection of Hardscrabble Road and West Chaffin Road and more significant, yet to be determined improvements at the intersection of Hardscrabble Road and East Chaffin Road.
