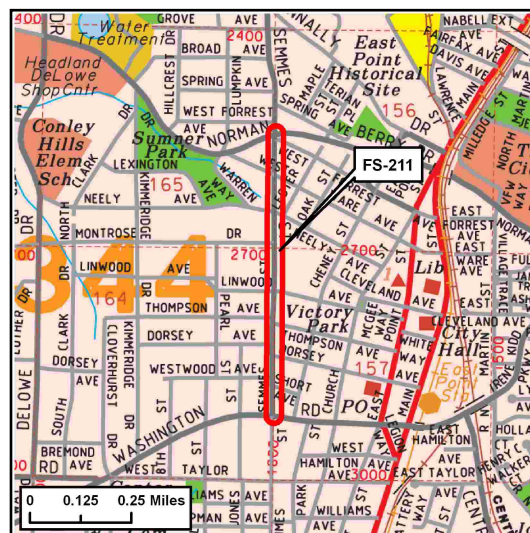

## Detailed Description and Justification

This project will improve safety for bicyclists and pedestrians along the corridor. The typical cross section includes two 11' wide traffic lanes, two 4' wide bicycle lanes, one 8' wide parking lane and two 6' wide sidewalks. All work will occur within the existing right-of-way. This is the first phase of a three phase project which will ultimately extend northward to Connally Drive and southward to East Farris Avenue. Engineering and design work will be undertaken for the entire corridor, with construction for the segments north of Norman Berry Drive and south of Washington Road to be funded locally and added to the TIP once cost estimates are developed.
