Detailed Description and Justification

This project will construction bicycle and pedestrian facilities along West Broad Street. Limits of this project are West Broad Street from Smith Street to Highway 138 (1.1 mi.) and Campbellton Road from Broad Street to Washington Street (200LF); Smith Street from Broad Street to Washington Street (200LF) and Washington Street from Smith to Campbellton Road (200LF). West Broad Street will construct sidewalks, crossing medians, on-street parking, and intersection improvements at Campbellton Road, Smith and Dodd Streets. Campbellton Road and Smith Road sections will construct sidewalks and parallel parking. West Broad Street/Highway 92 will construct 10' multi-use path on west side (alongside RR tracks) from Smith Street to Highway 138 and improve existing pedestrian RR underpass.
