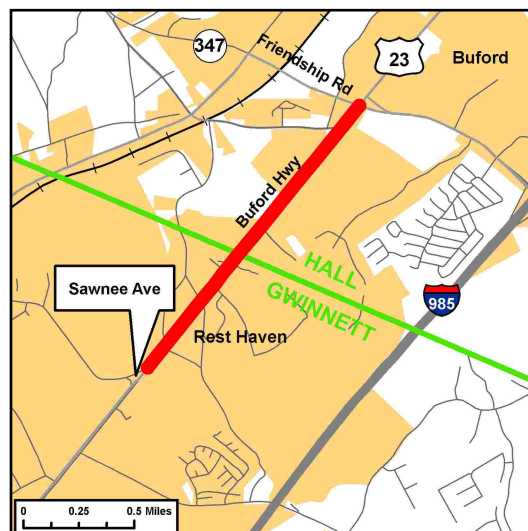

Detailed Description and Justification

This project will consist of widening the existing 2 lane section of US 23 (Buford Highway) from Thompson Mill Road to SR 347 (Friendship Road) to a 4 lane divided section. This will match the existing 4 lane section south of Sawnee Drive to SR 20 and improve traffic flow, relieve congestion, improve safety on this regional transportation corridor. The project will also include a 20-foot raised median and auxiliary lanes at major intersections. The roadway would have 12-foot urban shoulders with curb and gutter and 5-foot sidewalks on both sides.
