Detailed Description and Justification

This project involves constructing a new four-lane roadway linking SR 155 (Decatur Road) with SR 20 (Conyers Highway / Lawrenceville Street) on the northeast side of McDonough. The Metro Arterial Connector (MAC) is a network of state highways approximately 180 miles in length encircling the Atlanta region. Roadways comprising the MAC (primarily SR 20 and SR 92) are proposed to have a minimum of four travel lanes along its entire length. At least 30 capacity projects are already planned along the MAC over the timeframe of the RTP. A study will be conducted to determine how these individual projects can be engineered and constructed in a holistic and logical manner to maximize the multimodal mobility, safety, accessibility and growth management benefits of the project.
