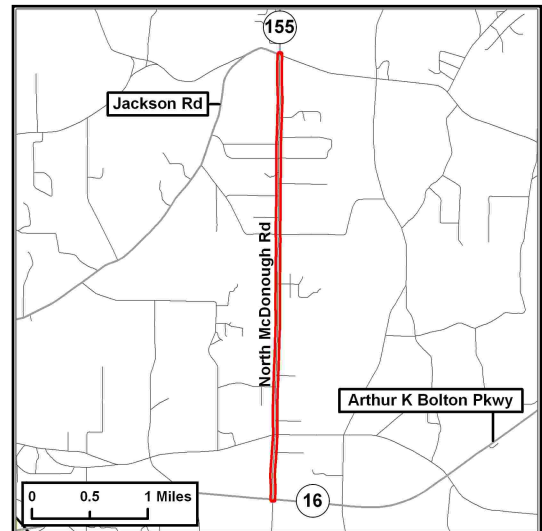

Detailed Description and Justification
