
Making the Region Bikeable and Walkable

The 2007 Atlanta Region Bicycle Transportation & Pedestrian Walkways Plan identified a strategic bicycle and pedestrian network of regionally significant corridors and centers. This network is prioritized in PLAN 2040 for future federal funding investments to support bicyclists and pedestrians due to its ability to serve regional trips. This concept seeks to make regional corridors and centers more multi-modal by improving safety, mobility, and accessibility for bicyclists and pedestrians.

Included in the FY 2012-2017 TIP is a new Last Mile Connectivity Program funded at \$50 million to implement bicycle and pedestrian projects that support the regional bicycle and pedestrian network. Projects to be funded out of this program will be identified in 2012. Total funding for bicycle and pedestrian infrastructure in PLAN 2040 totals \$1.6 billion through the year 2040.
