GO! Transit Capital Program (GOTCP) Background

- \$75 million competitive funding program for transit capital statewide
- Eligible projects include buses, technology, maintenance facilities, shelters, etc.
- Final project awards by SRTA Board
- GRTA assisted with criteria development and will assist with application review

GOTCP Background

- Projects best meeting program investment goals will be given the greatest consideration:
 - Increase economic competitiveness
 - Strengthen access and connectivity
 - Improve mobility and system integration
 - Maintain and optimize system assets
 - Improve safety, etc.
- Greater consideration also given for project readiness and larger match amounts (especially local funds)

The GO! Transit Capital Program is a competitive funding program designed to address some of the critical capital-related public transportation needs throughout Georgia. During the 2015 Legislative Session, the Georgia General Assembly designated \$75 million in General Obligation bond funds for the program and identified the State Road and Tollway Authority (SRTA) to administer it. Existing public transportation operators that are government units as well as local, regional, and state government units, including Community Improvement Districts, are all eligible to apply for the GO! Transit Capital Program.
