Description, Purpose and	This project provides funding for a fully integrated Mobility Management Call Center and the Atlanta Region needing transportation service, including older adults, persons with county Atlanta region. transportation services will continue to grow. The project implements a one-stop call center to provide comprehensive information on human services transportation and trip planning assistance that matches individuals with the most efficient and least expensive travel option. The Center creates a physical system that allows centralized scheduling, dispatching, vehicle tracking and trip booking, while ultimately providing a fully integrated human service transportation system across the 10-county region. Based on data from various regional programs, in the first three years of operation, the call center is estimated to provide over 200,000 people per year with information, eligibility screening and trip planning assistance. When fully operational, with an integrated technology system, the center is estimated to schedule over 400,000 trips yearly. The total cost of this project is \$17,000,000, which will be entirely funded under TIA.
