
WHEREAS, the City of Decatur has commenced the design of the Clairemont-Commerce-Church Street pedestrian safety and bicycle trail improvements; and,

WHEREAS, the construction of the Clairemont-Commerce-Church Street pedestrian safety and bicycle trail improvements is a vital element in implementing the Community Transportation Plan and encouraging healthier and safer transportation options for residents and visitors to the City of Decatur.
