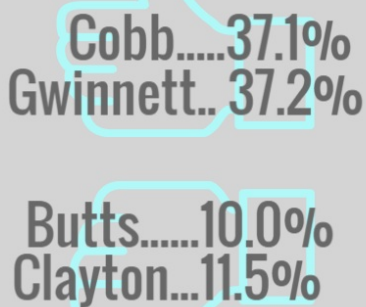


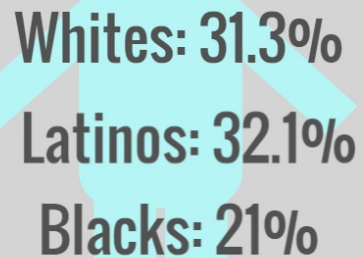


Q. What is the Biggest Problem Facing metro Atlanta?

Improve Roads & Highways 31%

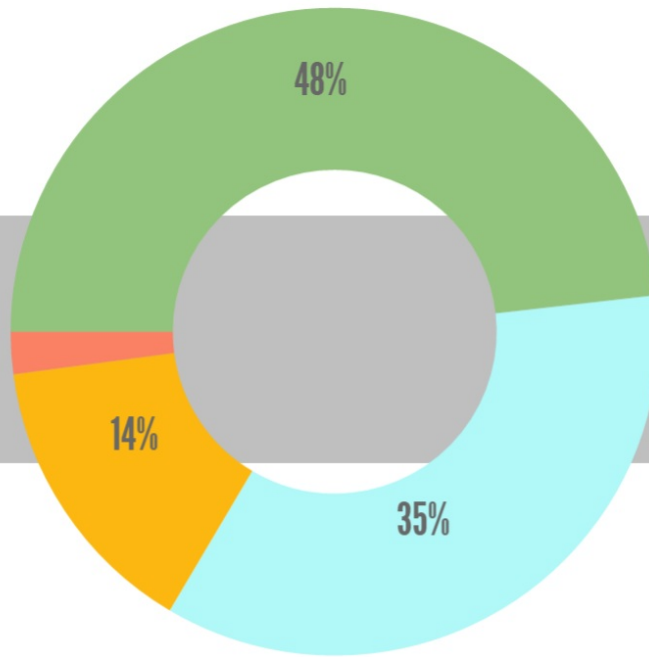
Top counties that believe Expanding Public Transit is Very Important
